- Welcomed seasonal employees Rodney Herfel and Dayton Keosackdy who recently began working at the Airport with a very positive impact on landscaping.
- Business development progress:
 - Allied Boats has moved into the Port's new 5,300 sf building. The building will be used as a finishing facility and will be a showroom in the future.
 - Working with a private developer who is submitting proposals to two separate tenants to construct buildings for them in the industrial park.
- Money from the 2020 CARES Act of \$69,000 for airport operational expenses will fund an emergency backup generator for the Port's wastewater facility. The Port is currently researching opportunities for a new 2021 grant of \$23,000.
- An Air Force C130 transport will come into the airport tomorrow. A photo of the plane was shown, and Airport Manager Henderson provided detail on the aircraft.
- Reported that at the Washington Public Ports Association (WPPA) Spring Conference, the Port of Bremerton was awarded the 2021 Job Creator of the Year which goes to the Port that best exemplifies growth and creation of sustainable living wage jobs in the community which increases economic opportunity. Commissioner Bozeman, who accepted the award on behalf of the Port, stated he was proud of the Port team and discussed the accomplishment. Commissioner Anderson stated Commissioner Bozeman made a great presentation and that this is a great story which needs to be told anywhere we can.

Summary:

On August 9, 2019, Port Commission approved the design and engineering contract for the development of a 12-acre site known as the SR3 Frontage Development. Site development and construction were approved in the 2020 Capital Budget and the contract was awarded to Henderson Partners, LLC. This project is nearing completion. During the fire alarm inspection, the City of Bremerton changed their requirements. In the engineering drawings (approved by the City of Bremerton), there were 3 heat sensor monitors listed. However, upon physical inspection of the building, the Fire Marshal required an additional 4 heat sensors.

Change Order 7 consists of the following changes:

• The addition of 4 Fire Alarm Heat Sensors as required by the City of Bremerton.

The cost of this Change Order is \$3,815 (Incl WSST).

<u>Fiscal Impact</u>: Current Project Budget: \$2,650,000 The cost of this Change Order is \$3,815 (Incl WSST). The total cost of construction, with this change order: \$2,458,560.10 Under Budget: \$191,439.90
