The following items take precedence over the initial bid specifications, where supplemented here. The original requirements, not affected by this addendum, shall remain in effect.

- 1. Question: The RFP requests an "Alternate #1" which would be the addition of "Insulation"
 - What is the type of Insulation Requested (Rigid or Vinyl Blanket)?
 - What R-Value (Specifically) is the Port requesting to be installed?

Answer: It is up to the contractor whether to use rigid of vinyl blanket for bidding the alternate.

A minimum R-Value of 11.

Clarification: The Alternate price should include the additional cost of roof materials (if any) required to be upgraded to accommodate the insulation, as well as the insulation material and labor.

2. Question: Were you asking for a warranty?

Answer: 1 yr. manufacturer from RoofHugger® and a 20 yr. warranty of weather tightness for panels per the panel manufacturer.

3. Question: Please confirm if it is a standing seam or exposed fastener.

Answer: Standing seam/seamless only.

4. Question: Will you consider a TPO roof alternate.

Answer: No

5. Question: Are there hour restrictions for working? Are there parking restrictions?

Answer: Parking directly at on work site is limited. Parking in close proximity is available. Working days are Monday through Friday with consideration of tenants.

6. Question: What is the specification of the metal panels to be installed?

Answer: 24 gauge that can withstand 5 ft spacing. On the bid pricing proposal, indicate the manufacturer and spec of the panel you will be installing.

7. Question: Will the surface be painted?

Answer: Yes. White.

8. Question: Are gutters and downspouts to be replaced?

Answer: Yes, 6"+ seamless gutters, white with 6" downspouts. Includes removal and disposal of old gutters.

9. Question: At 5695 Imperial Way will the front and back canopies be included?

Answer: Yes, but no insulation for the canopies for the alternate.

10. Question: At 5737 Imperial Way will the skylights be abandoned?

Answer: Yes, they will be covered with the new roof.

11. Question: Will the panel need to be mechanically seamed?

Answer: Yes, to manufacturer warrantied specifications.

12. Question: Please confirm whether the perimeter roof trims (eave gutter, gable/rake trims, and downspouts) also need to be replaced with new materials.

Answer: Yes

13. Question: Substitution request for VP Buildings SSR Cover-Rib Retrofit Roof.

Answer: Approved

14. Question: Please specify the Weathertightness Warranty period, if required.

Answer: 20 yr.

15. Question: Please confirm the new roof at 5737 will not require translucent skylight panels to match

existing.
